3 **ORDINANCE NO. 19291**

5 AN ORDINANCE introduced by Councilmember Jeff Preisner establishing the
6 Softball/Sports Facilities Reserve Fund in City of Topeka Code § 2-
7 322, amending the procedures established by Ordinance No.
8 16269 and repealing said ordinance.

10 WHEREAS, on January 22, 1991, the City Council passed and approved City of
11 Topeka Ordinance No. 16269 established a Softball/Sports Facilities Reserve Fund;
12 and

13 WHEREAS, that ordinance required that a resolution be approved by the Council
14 for expenditures from the fund to be granted; and

15 WHEREAS, it is desirable for the City Manager to have the authority to grant
16 approval of expenditures; and

17 WHEREAS, the ordinance relating to this fund shall be codified.

18 THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
19 TOPEKA, KANSAS:

20 Section 1. That the Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended
21 by adding a section to be numbered 2-322, which said section reads as follows:

22 (a) There is hereby created a Softball/Sports Facilities Reserve Fund.

23 (b) The purpose of the Softball/Sports Facilities Reserve fund shall be to act
24 as a depository for monies to be used for the repair, acquisition of land, design,
25 renovation, replacement, construction or addition to softball/sports facilities.

26 (c) The Softball/Sports Facilities Reserve Fund may receive fees collected by
27 the Parks and Recreation Department, as well as budgeted transfers from the Parks
28 and Recreation Fund, or any other fund having available resources and the legal

29 authority to be so transferred. All such transfers shall be subject to budget
30 appropriations approved by the City Council.

31 (d) All expenditures from the Softball/Sports Facilities Reserve Fund shall
32 only be for the purpose stated herein. All expenditures shall be initiated by
33 recommendation from the director of the department of parks and recreation and
34 approved by the city manager.

35 Section 2. City of Topeka Ordinance No. 16269 is hereby repealed.

36 Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its
37 passage, approval and publication in the official City newspaper.
