3 ORDINANCE NO. 18623

5 AN ORDINANCE introduced by City Manager Norton N. Bonaparte, Jr., amending the
6 project budget and authorizing as amended Improvement Project No.
7 29103-01 which provides for improvements to the sanitary sewer
8 service to Deer Creek South basin, and specifically repealing those
9 sections of City of Topeka Ordinance No. 18441 in conflict with this
10 Ordinance.

12 WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Topeka did pass and approve Ordinance No.
13 18441 which authorized Improvement Project No. 29103-01 with a project budget of three
14 million five hundred thousand dollars (\$3,500,000.00) and authorized the issuance of three
15 million five hundred thousand dollars (\$3,500,000.00) of combined water, wastewater, and
16 stormwater revenue bonds (“utility revenue bonds”); and

17 WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the project budget to cover additional design,
18 engineering and construction costs.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
20 TOPEKA, KANSAS:

21 Section 1. That it is hereby deemed advisable and necessary and is also hereby
22 authorized that the following public improvement be made:

23 A. GENERAL NATURE OF IMPROVEMENT:

24 The improvements will include the design of two pump stations, construction
25 of one pumpstation, and the design and construction of a force main to the
26 nearest interceptor sewer to serve the Deer Creek South basin and related
27 appurtenances for a complete project and doing all things necessary and
28 incidental thereto (the “Project”).

30 B. TOTAL PROJECT BUDGET COST:

\$800,000.00 Combined water, wastewater, and stormwater utility operating funds and any other legally available funds.

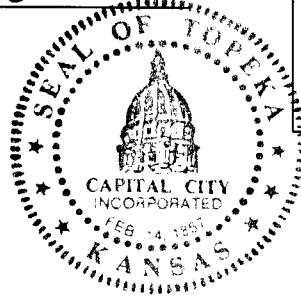

That the sections of City of Topeka Ordinance No. 18441 which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby specifically repealed and the rest and remainder of Ordinance 18441 which authorized issuance of three million five hundred thousand dollars (\$3,500,000.00) of utility revenue bonds shall remain in force and effect.
