6 AN ORDINANCE introduced by Deputy Mayor Jeff Preisner amending City of Topeka
7 Code § 2-333 concerning the golf course improvement reserve fund
8 and specifically repealing said original section.

10 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:

11 Section 1. City of Topeka Code § 2-333, Golf course improvement reserve
12 fund, is hereby amended to read as follows:

13 **Golf course improvement reserve fund.**

14 (a) There is hereby created a golf course improvement reserve fund. The
15 fund is established for the purpose of a depository for moneys to be used for capital
16 improvements at the city golf course.

17 (b) Beginning January 1, 2002 the fund shall receive seven percent of golf
18 course greens' fees and annual permit fees, grants or donations from either public or
19 private sources, interest on the funds held in the fund, and any other fund having
20 available resources legal authority to be so deposited or transferred. All such transfers
21 shall be subject to budget appropriations and shall be specifically authorized by
22 resolution of the city council. All expenditures from the fund shall only be for the
23 purpose stated in this section and shall only be made upon approval by ~~resolution of the~~
24 ~~city council~~ the City Manager.

25 Section 2. Original City of Topeka Code § 2-333 is hereby specifically
26 repealed.

27 Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force after its passage,
28 approval and publication in the official city newspaper.
