3 ORDINANCE NO. 18684

5 AN ORDINANCE introduced by City Manager Norton N. Bonaparte, Jr. relating to the
6 amendments of the current edition of the Standard Traffic
7 Ordinance for Kansas Cities to incorporate the 2006 legislative
8 changes regarding suspended driver's licenses and driving while an
9 habitual violator, amending City of Topeka Code § 142-152 and
10 specifically repealing said original section.

12 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:

13 Section 1. That City of Topeka Code § 142-152, Amendments, is hereby
14 amended to read as follows:

15 **Amendments.**

16 The current edition of the Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities as
17 adopted by reference, shall be amended as follows:

18 (a) Section 1 of the standard traffic ordinance, relating to definitions, is hereby
19 amended as follows:

20 Other competent evidence includes: (1) Alcohol concentration tests obtained from
21 samples taken two hours or more after the operation or attempted operation of a
22 vehicle; and (2) readings obtained from a partial alcohol concentration test on a breath
23 testing machine.

24 All other definitions not modified, deleted or changed shall remain in effect.

25 (b) Section 13 of the standard traffic ordinance, relating to traffic control signal
26 legend, is hereby declared to be and is omitted and deleted.

27 (c) Section 33 of the standard traffic ordinance, relating to maximum speed
28 limits, is hereby declared to be and is omitted and deleted.

29 (d) Section 37 of the standard traffic ordinance, relating to racing on
30 highways; exhibition of speed, is amended to read as follows:

31 No person shall drive any vehicle on any road, street, alley, public or private parking lot
32 or highway in the city in any race, speed competition or contest, drag race or
33 acceleration contest, test of physical endurance, exhibition of speed or acceleration, or
34 for the purpose of making a speed record, and no person shall in any manner
35 participate in any such race, competition, contest, test or exhibition.

36 (e) Section 50 of the standard traffic ordinance relating to right, left and U-
37 turns at intersection: obedience to, is hereby declared to be and is omitted and deleted.

38 (f) Section 67 of the standard traffic ordinance, relating to pedestrians to use
39 right half of crosswalks, is hereby declared to be and is omitted and deleted.

40 (g) Section 104 of the standard traffic ordinance, relating to inattentive driving,
41 is hereby declared to be and is omitted and deleted.

42 (h) Section 119 of the standard traffic ordinance, relating to parades and
43 processions, is hereby declared to be and is omitted and deleted.

44 ~~(i) Section 198 of the standard traffic ordinance, relating to vehicle license;
45 illegal tag, is hereby declared to be and is omitted and deleted.~~

46 (i) Section 194 of the standard traffic ordinance, relating to driving while
47 license canceled, suspended or revoked, is hereby declared to be and is omitted and
48 deleted.

49 (j) Section 195.1 of the standard traffic ordinance, relating to operation of a
50 motor vehicle when a habitual violator is hereby declared to be and is omitted and
51 deleted.

52 (k) Section 198 of the standard traffic ordinance, relating to vehicle license;
53 illegal tag, is hereby declared to be and is omitted and deleted.

54 Section 2. That City of Topeka Code § 142-152 is hereby specifically
55 repealed.

56 Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its
57 passage, approval and publication in the official City newspaper.
