2 ORDINANCE NO. 18721

3 AN ORDINANCE introduced by City Manager Norton N. Bonaparte, Jr., authorizing  
4 Improvement Project No. 30127-12, which provides for the  
5 development of plans and specifications to extend the existing Shunga  
6 Multipurpose Trail, as more specifically described herein, all pursuant  
7 to Section A12-1 of the Code of the City of Topeka.

8 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:

9 Section 1. That it is hereby deemed advisable and necessary and is also hereby  
10 authorized, pursuant to Section A12-1 of the Code of the City of Topeka, that the following  
11 public improvement be made:

12 A. GENERAL NATURE OF IMPROVEMENT:

13 The project will include the development of plans and specifications to extend  
14 the existing Shunga Multipurpose Trail westerly and southerly following  
15 Shunga Creek on the north side of the Creek from SW Fairlawn Street to the  
16 south side of SW 29<sup>th</sup> Street. This project includes design and construction  
17 of a 10-foot wide concrete sidewalk, bridge across the Creek, slope  
18 stabilization, retaining walls, construction inspection, project administration,  
19 and right-of-way acquisition.

20 B. TOTAL PROJECT BUDGET COST:

21 \$564,700.00

22 C. SOURCE OF FUNDS:

23	Kansas Department of Transportation Grant	\$421,200.00
24	General Obligation Bonds and any other	
25	lawfully available funds	<u>\$143,500.00</u>
26	Total	\$564,700.00

27 Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
28 passage, approval, and publication in the official city newspaper.
