6 AN ORDINANCE introduced by City Manager Norton N. Bonaparte, Jr., authorizing
7 Improvement Project No. 30269-00, which provides for new walks
8 throughout the botanical garden area in Old Prairie Town, as more
9 specifically described herein, all pursuant to Section A12-1 of the
10 Code of the City of Topeka.

12 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:

14 Section 1. That it is hereby deemed advisable and necessary and is also hereby
15 authorized, pursuant to Section A12-1 of the Code of the City of Topeka that the following
16 public improvement be made:

17 A. GENERAL NATURE OF IMPROVEMENT:

19 This project will provide for the installation of new walks throughout the
20 botanical garden area where there is currently only grass pathways that do
21 not meet the ADA standards. This project will also include a sound wall
22 adjacent to I-70 along the north side of the park, and replace some of the
23 existing wire fence with a decorative fence. All funds will be used for
24 construction. The design work will be completed by the Parks and
25 Recreation Department.
