4 **ORDINANCE NO. 18856**

6 AN ORDINANCE introduced by City Manager Norton N. Bonaparte, Jr., authorizing  
7 Improvement Project No. 30274-00, which provides for restrooms at  
8 Gage Park and Oakland Park, as more specifically described herein,  
9 all pursuant to Section A12-1 of the Code of the City of Topeka.

11 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:

13 Section 1. That it is hereby deemed advisable and necessary and is also hereby  
14 authorized, pursuant to Section A12-1 of the Code of the City of Topeka that the following  
15 public improvement be made:

16 A. GENERAL NATURE OF IMPROVEMENT:

17  
18 This project will provide the construction of restrooms in Gage Park and  
19 Oakland Park. The Gage restroom will be located adjacent to the horseshoe  
20 courts. This facility will also serve two open-air shelters, a play structure and  
21 the Hills Bark Park. The restroom in Oakland Park will replace an existing  
22 restroom. This restroom will service the baseball fields, The Mouse Trap  
23 Skate Park, and a tot play structure. Both restrooms will be prefab  
24 structures. Utilities extension, demolition of existing restroom, and  
25 connective sidewalks are included in this project. All funds will be used for  
26 construction. The design work will be completed by the Parks and  
27 Recreation Department.

33 C. SOURCE OF FUNDS:

35 General Obligation Bonds or  
36 any other lawfully available funds \$212,000.00

38 Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
39 passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper.
