4 **ORDINANCE NO. 18919**

6 AN ORDINANCE introduced by City Manager Norton N. Bonaparte, Jr., amending the
7 project budget and authorizing as amended Street Improvement
8 Project No. 70190-01, Part B, which provides for the reconstruction of
9 E. 6th Street to five lanes wide between Golden Avenue and Market
10 Street, as more specifically described herein, pursuant to Section
11 A12-1 of the Code of the City of Topeka, and repealing City of Topeka
12 Ordinance No. 18516.

14 WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Topeka adopted Ordinance No. 18516,
15 effective on October 5, 2005, which authorized Street Improvement Project No. 70190-01,
16 Part B, which provides for the reconstruction of E. 6th Street to five lanes from Golden
17 Avenue to Market Street. These improvements included new pavement, sidewalks, storm
18 sewers and other incidentals, with a project budget of one million five hundred seventy-four
19 thousand two hundred twenty-seven dollars (\$1,574,227.00) of General Obligation Bonds
20 and any other lawfully available funds; and

21 WHEREAS, it is necessary to increase the project budget by four hundred seventy-
22 one thousand seven hundred and seventy three dollars (\$471,773.00) because actual bids
23 on the project were approximately three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000.00) over the
24 original estimate and right-of-way and relocation costs exceeded estimates by
25 approximately one hundred seventy thousand dollars (\$170,000.00).

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
27 TOPEKA, KANSAS:

28 Section 1. That it is hereby deemed advisable and necessary and is also hereby
29 authorized pursuant to Section A12-1 of the Code of the City of Topeka that the following
30 public improvement be made:

A. GENERAL NATURE OF IMPROVEMENT:

This project will reconstruct E. 6th Street to five lanes wide between Golden Avenue and Market Street and improve safety by moving the intersection of E. 6th Street and E. 10th Street farther west between S.E. Davies Street and S.E. Burr Street. The project will provide new pavement, sidewalks, storm sewers and other incidentals.

B. TOTAL PROJECT BUDGET COST:

\$2,046,000.00

C. SOURCE OF FUNDS:

General Obligation Bonds or any other lawfully available funds.

Section 2. Ordinance No. 18516 is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper.
