4 **ORDINANCE NO. 18949**

5  
6 AN ORDINANCE introduced by City Manager Norton N. Bonaparte, Jr., amending the  
7 project budget and authorizing as amended Trafficway Improvement  
8 Project No. 70179, which provides for improvement of Huntoon Street  
9 from Fairlawn Road to McAlister Street, and specifically repealing City  
10 of Topeka Ordinance No. 17487, all pursuant to K.S.A. 12-685, *et seq.*  
11 and Section A12-1 of the Code of the City of Topeka.

13 WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Topeka did pass and approve Ordinance No.  
14 17487 which authorized Improvement Project No.70179 with a project budget of two million  
15 one hundred six thousand three hundred seventy dollars (\$2,106,370.00) of which eight  
16 hundred seventy-one thousand three hundred seventy dollars (\$871,370.00) would be paid  
17 for by General Obligation Bonds and the remaining one million two hundred thirty-five  
18 thousand dollars (\$1,235,000.00) would be paid for by Federal Highway Administration STP  
19 funds; and

20 WHEREAS, it is necessary to increase the project budget by one hundred fifty  
21 thousand three hundred nine dollars (\$150,309.00) to reimburse KDOT for certain waterline  
22 relocation costs; and

23 WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Topeka (the "City") is empowered pursuant to  
24 K.S.A. 12-685 et seq. (the "Act") to designate as main trafficways certain existing streets,  
25 the primary function of which is the movement of through traffic between areas of  
26 concentrated activity within the City; and

27 WHEREAS, Huntoon Street from 300 feet east of Fairlawn Road to McAlister Street  
28 presently carries significant vehicular traffic between areas of concentrated activity within  
29 the City; and

31 WHEREAS, pursuant to the Act, the Council of the City is empowered to improve  
32 any main trafficway and to pay for such costs by the City at large, by the issuance of  
33 general improvement bonds of the City or any other fund or funds available for such  
34 purposes; and

35 WHEREAS, the City is authorized pursuant to City of Topeka Code § A12-1 to issue  
36 and sell general obligation bonds for the purpose of paying for improvement, repair or  
37 extension to the City's public buildings and improvements including streets, sidewalks,  
38 waterworks system and sanitary and stormwater sewage disposal system.

39 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
40 TOPEKA, KANSAS:

41 Section 1. That it is hereby deemed advisable and necessary and is also hereby  
42 authorized that the following public improvement be made:

43 A. GENERAL NATURE OF IMPROVEMENT:

44  
45 This project reconstructed S.W. Huntoon Street from 300 feet east of  
46 Fairlawn Road to McAlister Street to four (4) lanes. Project included new  
47 concrete pavement, curb & gutter, sidewalk and drainage facilities.
