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3 **ORDINANCE NO. 19167**

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5 AN ORDINANCE introduced by Deputy Mayor Jeff Preisner amending City of Topeka  
6 Code § 110-35 concerning a quorum of the Topeka Planning  
7 Commission and specifically repealing said original section.  
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9 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:

10 Section 1. That section 110-35, Quorum, of The Code of the City of Topeka,  
11 Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

13 **Quorum.**

14 (a) A quorum of the Topeka Planning Commission shall consist of ~~seven (7)~~  
15 five (5) members. Except as otherwise provided by state law requiring a higher number  
16 of affirmative votes, any matter requiring that a recommendation be made to the city  
17 council shall require the affirmative votes of not less than a majority of the ~~quorum~~  
18 ~~present at such meeting~~membership of the Topeka Planning Commission. The  
19 secretary shall record all votes taken by name, indicating whether the member voted in  
20 the affirmative or negative or abstained, and a copy of such record shall be transmitted  
21 to the city council following each meeting of the Topeka Planning Commission. The  
22 planning director shall serve as secretary to the Topeka Planning Commission. The  
23 secretary shall cause a proper record to be kept of all the proceedings of the Topeka  
24 Planning Commission.

25 Section 2. That section 110-35 of The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is  
26 hereby specifically repealed.

27 Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
28 passage, approval and publication in the official City newspaper.
