3 **ORDINANCE NO. 19497**

5 AN ORDINANCE introduced Councilmember Karen Hiller authorizing the sale,
6 consumption and possession of alcoholic liquor at a specified location
7 and time for The Office and The Celtic Fox for New Year's Eve.

9 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF

10 TOPEKA, KANSAS, that:

11 Section 1. Authorization is given to barricade a portion of the sidewalk adjacent to
12 124 SW 8th Street and 118 SW 8th Street from December 31, 2010, at 4:00 p.m. through
13 January 1, 2011, at 1:00 a.m. Attendance to the celebration is open to the public between
14 these hours.

15 Section 2. The barricaded portion of the sidewalk adjacent to 124 SW 8th Street
16 and 118 SW 8th Street shall be temporarily removed from the City's right-of-way and the
17 provisions of K.S.A. 41-719. Vendors holding the appropriate license from the State of
18 Kansas to sell alcoholic liquor may in accordance with all applicable state laws and
19 municipal ordinances sell alcoholic liquor in the specific area designated by the division of
20 Alcohol Beverage Control within the barricaded portion of the sidewalk adjacent to 124 SW
21 8th Street and 118 SW 8th Street from December 31, 2010, at 4:00 p.m. through January 1,
22 2011, at 1:00 a.m.

23 Section 3. Event attendees may buy, possess and consume alcoholic beverages
24 in the specific area designated by the division of Alcohol Beverage Control within the
25 barricaded portion of the sidewalk adjacent to 124 SW 8th Street and 118 SW 8th Street
26 from December 31, 2010, at 4:00 p.m. through January 1, 2011, at 1:00 a.m.

27 Section 4. This Ordinance shall be null and void at 1:01 a.m. on January 1, 2011.
