4 **ORDINANCE NO. 19525**

6 AN ORDINANCE introduced Councilmember Karen Hiller authorizing the sale,  
7 consumption and possession of alcoholic liquor at a specified location  
8 and time for The Office on March 17, 2011.

10 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
11 TOPEKA, KANSAS, that:

12 Section 1. Authorization is given to barricade a portion of the sidewalk adjacent to  
13 124 SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street on March 17, 2011, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 11:59 p.m.  
14 Attendance to the celebration is open to the public between these hours.

15 Section 2. The barricaded portion of the sidewalk adjacent to 124 SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street  
16 shall be temporarily removed from the City's right-of-way and the provisions of K.S.A. 41-  
17 719. Vendors holding the appropriate license from the State of Kansas to sell alcoholic  
18 liquor may in accordance with all applicable state laws and municipal ordinances sell  
19 alcoholic liquor in the specific area designated by the division of Alcohol Beverage Control  
20 within the barricaded portion of the sidewalk adjacent to 124 SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street between the  
21 hours of 9:00 a.m. and 11:59 p.m. on March 17, 2011.

22 Section 3. Event attendees may buy, possess and consume alcoholic beverages  
23 in the specific area designated by the division of Alcohol Beverage Control within the  
24 barricaded portion of the sidewalk adjacent to 124 SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street between the hours of 9:00  
25 a.m. and 11:59 p.m. on March 17, 2011.

26 Section 4. This Ordinance shall be null and void on March 18, 2011.

27 Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force after its passage,  
28 approval and publication in the official city newspaper.
