3 **ORDINANCE NO. 19661**

5 AN ORDINANCE introduced by Councilmember Karen Hiller designating the Big  
6 Gage Shelter House as temporarily exempt from the provisions of  
7 K.S.A. 41-719(c) and TMC 9.15.020(d).  
8

9 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA,  
10 KANSAS, THAT:

11 Section 1. Pursuant to K.S.A. 41-719(d) and TMC 9.15.020(d)(5), the City  
12 Council may exempt public property from the prohibitions concerning drinking or  
13 consuming alcoholic liquor on public property.

14 Section 2. That, in accordance with such authority, the City exempts Big Gage  
15 Shelter House, from the prohibition of K.S.A. 41-719(c) and TMC 9.15.020(d). Such  
16 exemption is conditioned upon the following:

17 A. The occurrence of an event conducted under the auspices of the ERC to  
18 be held on November 3, 2011, between the hours of 6:30 p.m. and 8 p.m.;

19 and

20 B. ERC has complied with all the applicable state laws and municipal  
21 ordinances concerning alcoholic liquor.

22 Section 3. This Ordinance shall be null and void at 8 p.m. on November 3,  
23 2011.

24 Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
25 passage, approval and publication in the official City newspaper.
