

1 RESOLUTION NO. 7113

3 A RESOLUTION introduced by Mayor Joan Wagnon, declaring the eligibility of the
4 City of Topeka to submit an application to the Kansas Department of
5 Transportation for use of Transportation Enhancement funds as
6 provided for by the Federal Transportation Equity Act for the 21st
7 Century for the Great Overland Station Trailhead Project which
8 consists of storm water control measures, scenic interpretive site and
9 connection of the Great Overland Station area to the Kaw Reserve
10 Trail; approximate length of trail is 7 miles along U.S. Highway 75
11 in the City of Topeka and authorizing the Mayor to sign the
12 application.

14 WHEREAS, the City of Topeka, Kansas, has the legal authority to apply for,
15 receive, and administer federal, state, and other monies as authorized by K.S.A. 12-1662,
16 regarding the expenditure of federal aid to public agencies; and

17 WHEREAS, federal monies are available under a Transportation Enhancement
18 Program set forth by the Federal Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century,
19 administered by the State of Kansas, Department of Transportation, for the purpose of
20 historic, scenic and environmental and pedestrian and bicycle projects; and

21 WHEREAS, after due consideration, the Council of the City of Topeka, Kansas,
22 has recommended that an application be submitted to the State of Kansas for the Great
23 Overland Station Trailhead Project which consists of storm water control measures,
24 scenic interpretive site and connection of the Great Overland Station area to the Kaw
25 Reserve Trail; approximate length of trail is 7 miles along U.S. Highway 75.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY
27 OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:

28 Section 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to submit an application to the
29 Kansas Department of Transportation for Transportation Enhancement Program funds set
30 forth by the Federal Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century on behalf of the
31 citizens of the City of Topeka, Kansas, for the Great Overland Station Trailhead Project
32 which consists of storm water control measures, scenic interpretive site and connection of
33 the Great Overland Station area to the Kaw Reserve Trail; approximate length of trail is 7
34 miles along U.S. Highway 75.

35 Section 2. That the Council of the City of Topeka, Kansas, hereby assures the
36 Kansas Department of Transportation that sufficient funding for the construction of the
37 Great Overland Station Trailhead Project is available.

38 Section 3. That the Council of the City of Topeka, Kansas, hereby assures the
39 Kansas Department of Transportation that sufficient funding for the operation and
40 maintenance of the Great Overland Station Trailhead Project will be available for the life
41 of the project.

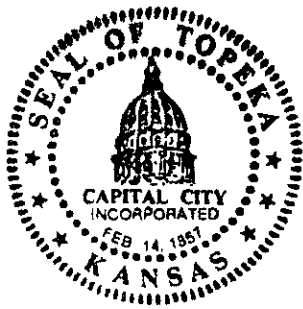
42 Section 4. That the Council of the City of Topeka, Kansas, hereby assures the
43 Kansas Department of Transportation that it will have title or permanent easement to the
44 Great Overland Station Trailhead Project by the time of project letting.

45 Section 5. That the Mayor of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is authorized to sign
46 the application to the Kansas Department of Transportation for transportation
47 enhancement program funds set forth by the Federal Transportation Equity Act for the
48 21st Century on behalf of the citizens of Topeka, Kansas. The Mayor is also authorized to

49 submit additional information as may be required and act as the official representative of
50 the City of Topeka, Kansas, in this and subsequent related activities.

51 Section 6. That the Council of the City of Topeka, Kansas, hereby assures the
52 Kansas Department of Transportation that it is willing and able to, if the Great Overland
53 Station Trailhead Project is selected for funding, administer the designing, letting and
54 construction of the Great Overland Station Trailhead Project.
