9 the revitalization of Downtown Topeka is critical to the economic future of our City; and


10 WHEREAS, The Historic Preservation Plan recognizes the unique age and  
11 architecture of many buildings in the Downtown Topeka area make it difficult for them to  
12 conform to the current building codes; and

13 WHEREAS, the City Council encourages public/private partnerships in seeking  
14 answers to our City's issues.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Topeka,  
16 Kansas that we support the collective efforts of the Topeka Fire Department, the  
17 Topeka-Shawnee County Metropolitan Planning Department, the Topeka Public Works  
18 Department, Downtown Topeka, Incorporated, and other entities that have come  
19 together, under the guidance of the Downtown element and the Landmark Preservation  
20 element of the Comprehensive Plan to review Topeka's existing building codes, explore  
21 and evaluate alternatives, and possibly recommend changes that will continue to ensure  
22 public safety and promote economic development by allowing the preservation and/or  
23 rehabilitation of buildings in Downtown Topeka.
