

RESOLUTION NO. 7188

A RESOLUTION introduced by Mayor Felker relating to Water Pollution Control Project No. 29091-4 Phase 1A, which provides for rehabilitation of the Oakland Waste Water Treatment Plant and authorizing the same.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Topeka that it finds the following described public improvement to be necessary and in the public interest and does hereby authorize as hereinafter described:

A. GENERAL NATURE OF IMPROVEMENT:

Phase 1A of the Water Pollution Control Project No. 29091-4, is the first phase of a three-phase program to rehabilitate the Oakland Waste Water Treatment Plant. Phase 1A consists of new preliminary treatment improvements including headworks, bar screens, grit removal, realignment of sewer force mains coming into the plant, a new flow splitter box, and all the associated pumping and piping.

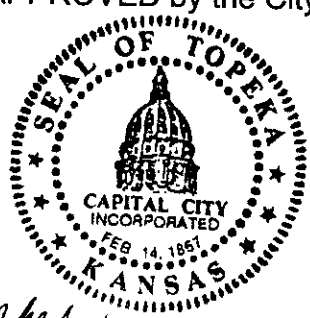
