

A RESOLUTION introduced by Mayor Felker authorizing the rehabilitation of the Great Overland Station, Project No. 13122, Phase II, and authorizing the same.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Topeka that it finds the following described public improvement to be necessary and in the public interest and does hereby authorize as hereinafter described:

A. GENERAL NATURE OF IMPROVEMENT:

To complete the construction of the Great Overland Station Depot. The rehabilitation of the depot will include the interior renovation to the central wing, east and east central wings. The project will also include site improvements including driveways to Curtis Street, a parking lot, landscaping, replace the brick loading platform and other appurtenances for a complete project.

B. ESTIMATED OR PROBABLE COST:

\$3,022,000.00

C. APPORTIONMENT OF COSTS:

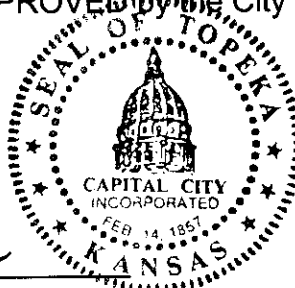
75% of the costs will be paid for through a Transportation Enhancement Grant from the Kansas Department of Transportation.

25% of the costs will be paid for through Railroad Heritage, Inc.
