4 A RESOLUTION introduced by Mayor Felker, approving the City of Topeka 2002  
5 Consolidated Action Plan and directing its submittal to the U.S.  
6 Department of Housing and Urban Development.

8 WHEREAS, the City of Topeka is desirous of obtaining federal funding under the  
9 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnership (HOME),  
10 Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG), and other programs; and

11 WHEREAS, the Consolidated Action Plan is a planning and resource allocation  
12 document required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD)  
13 in order for local units of government to receive certain federal grants; and

14 WHEREAS, regulations governing the Consolidated Action Plan, 24 C.F.R. Part 91,  
15 combine into a single submission the planning and application of elements of the  
16 Comprehensive Housing Affordability Strategy (CHAS), CDBG, ESG, and HOME  
17 programs.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Topeka,  
19 Kansas, that the 2002 Consolidated Action Plan attached hereto as Exhibit A be and  
20 hereby is adopted.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Topeka, Kansas, that  
22 appropriate City staff is directed to submit the Consolidated Action Plan to the HUD in  
23 accordance with applicable regulations.
