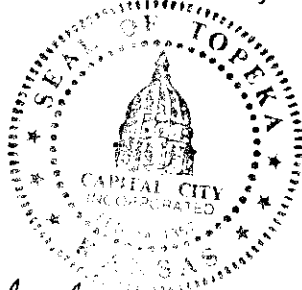

5 A RESOLUTION introduced by Mayor Felker authorizing initiation of condemnation  
6 proceedings for furtherance of the East Topeka Project as described in  
7 City of Topeka Resolution No. 7234.

9 BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Topeka, Kansas, pursuant to  
10 K.S.A. 26-201 that it is necessary and advisable in the public interest to condemn certain  
11 private property in the City for improvement of the East Topeka Project as described in City  
12 of Topeka Resolution No. 7234, and such other public purposes as are authorized by law.

13 Pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 26-201, the Engineering Division is hereby  
14 authorized and directed to cause a survey to be made by some competent engineer of  
15 those private lands which are necessary to be appropriated for the improvement, and such  
16 other public purposes as are authorized by law, and the City Engineer, or his designee, is  
17 authorized and directed to file the report of the survey, including a description of those  
18 private lands and interests to be acquired by condemnation, in the office of the City Clerk.

19 THIS RESOLUTION shall become effective upon one publication in the official city  
20 newspaper.
