

RESOLUTION NO. 7247

A RESOLUTION introduced by Mayor Harry Felker, describing Improvement Project No. 29091-4-1B which provides for the rehabilitation of the Oakland Treatment Plant and authorizing the same, and rescinding City of Topeka Resolution No. 7222.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Topeka that it finds the following described public improvement to be necessary and in the public interest and does hereby authorize Improvement Project No. 29091-4-1B as hereinafter described:

A. GENERAL NATURE OF IMPROVEMENT:

Phase 1B consists of the construction of two (2) new primary clarifiers, a new primary sludge pump station, odor control facilities, rehabilitation of the four (4) existing primary clarifiers with new clarifier mechanisms and odor control covers at the Oakland Waste Water Treatment Plant. The addition of two (2) new primary clarifiers will allow for primary treatment of combined storm/sanitary sewer flows up to 100 MGD.

The increased project budget will allow for the addition of two (2) plant pump stations, new boiler building, power and fiber optic loops for emergency response and operations monitoring, replacement of four (4) roofs which are in disrepair, and realignment and replacement of the sewer plant water lines.

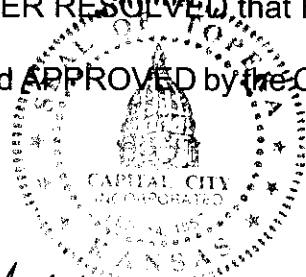
