A RESOLUTION introduced by Deputy Mayor Betty M. Dunn and Councilmember Clark Duffy, expressing the intent of the City Council to adopt a budget for the City of Topeka that requires no increase in the City's mill levy for 2003.

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to keep the City's tax level at the lowest level possible while providing essential services; and

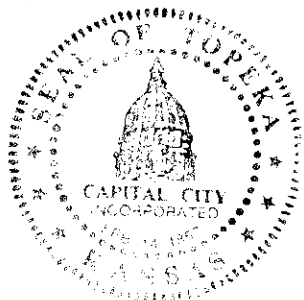
WHEREAS, lower taxation rates are an effective economic development tool, benefiting the City in its attempts to attract business.
