3 RESOLUTION OF ADVISABILITY AND AUTHORIZATION NO. 726D

5 A RESOLUTION introduced by Mayor Harry Felker, authorizing Improvement Project
6 No. 60561-02 which provides for the pavement of SW Red Oaks
7 Court from SW Red Oaks Place easterly and southerly to south end
8 of the cul-de-sac and authorizing the same.

10 WHEREAS, the City Council has received a petition, pursuant to K.S.A. 12-6a04,
11 containing the signatures of the owners of 100% of the area in the improvement district
12 hereinafter described; and

13 WHEREAS, seven (7) days have elapsed since the filing of said petition.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Topeka,
15 Kansas, that it finds Street Improvement Project No. 60561-02, hereinafter described, to be
16 advisable and does hereby authorize and order said improvement to be made in
17 accordance with its findings as follows:

18 A. GENERAL NATURE OF IMPROVEMENT:

20 To pave SW Red Oaks Court from SW Red Oaks Place easterly and
21 southerly to the south end of the cul-de-sac.

23 B. PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT:

25 Lots 1 through 21, Block "A", Red Oaks Place No. 3

33 On a unit basis for all lots, or parcels which are included in the
34 improvement district.

41 provide all publication and mailed notices in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 12-
42 6a09 as amended.

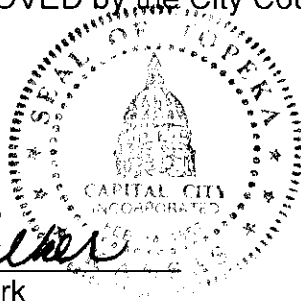
