4 A RESOLUTION introduced by Councilmember Clark Duffy, amending Article II,
5 Section 5 "Residency Requirement" of the City of Topeka Personnel
6 Rules and Regulations and rescinding City of Topeka Resolution No.
7 7246.

9 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Topeka that
10 Article II, Section 5 "Residency Requirement" of the Topeka Personnel Rules and
11 Regulations is hereby amended to read as follows:

12 **Residency Requirement.**

13 Specifications

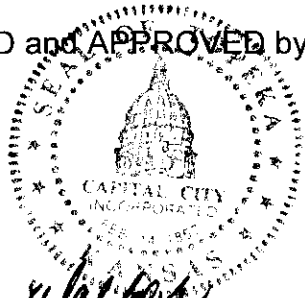
14 Employees employed after December 31, 1981, by the City must be bona fide
15 residents of Shawnee County, except at the time of appointment or employment when
16 they need not be residences of Shawnee County, but shall establish residency in
17 Shawnee County within six (6) months after completion of the initial employment
18 probation. Employees employed in a public safety position, as defined by the Personnel
19 Director, shall, within six (6) months after completion of the initial employment probation,
20 reside within the boundaries of Shawnee County at a location which is no more than
21 thirty (30) minutes travel time from their assigned reporting station or office. Said
22 residence shall be maintained within the boundaries of Shawnee County for the duration
23 of the employee's employment. The Chief Administrative Officer may grant one
24 extension not to exceed six (6) months for establishment of residency upon the request
25 of an individual employee for good cause shown. All employees of the City-County
26 Planning Agency shall reside within the boundaries of Shawnee County.

27 Department Head Residency
28 Unless specifically approved by the City Council, all department heads hired after
29 the effective date of this Resolution shall reside within the boundaries of the City of
30 Topeka. All department heads hired prior to the effective date of this Resolution shall
31 reside within the boundaries of Shawnee County. The salaries of those department
32 heads who reside within the boundaries of Shawnee County but are not bona fide
33 residents of the City or whose residences are not subject to a consent to annex, shall be
34 frozen at the rate of pay in effect on the date this Resolution is approved by the Topeka
35 City Council. The salaries of those department heads who are or become bona fide
36 residents of the City or whose residences are subject to a consent to annex shall not be
37 frozen and those department heads will receive pay increases as allowed by the City of
38 Topeka Personnel Rules and Regulations.

39 BE IT RESOLVED that City of Topeka Resolution No. 7246 is hereby specifically
40 rescinded.

41 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the original of Article II, Section 5 "Residency
42 Requirement" of the City of Topeka Personnel Rules and Regulations is hereby
43 repealed.
