

RESOLUTION NO. 7270

A RESOLUTION introduced by Mayor Harry Felker relating to a grant application for the Hi-Crest Neighborhood Plan.

WHEREAS, the City of Topeka is collaborating with the Hi-Crest Neighborhood Improvement Association on a neighborhood revitalization plan, and have identified an opportunity to apply for a year 2002 Metropolitan Community Capacity Building Grant from the Kansas Department of Commerce & Housing in support of that plan, and

WHEREAS, the grant will be used to develop a master land use plan for an undeveloped area bounded by the Landon Trail, SE Adams Street, SE 31<sup>st</sup> Street, and SE 29<sup>th</sup> Street, within the Hi-Crest neighborhood, to include a master site plan, preliminary architectural renderings, and infrastructure plans, as funding allows, for an area beginning approximately 1000 feet south of SE 29<sup>th</sup> Street, and bounded by the Landon Trail, SE Fremont Street, and SE 31<sup>st</sup> Street, and


WHEREAS, the City of Topeka has adopted a Neighborhood Element to the Topeka-Shawnee County Metropolitan Comprehensive Plan which specifies this portion of the Hi-Crest neighborhood for HIGH PRIORITY planning and funding assistance, and

WHEREAS, the grant will be administered by the Topeka-Shawnee County Metropolitan Planning Department,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Topeka, Kansas, that we pledge our support of a 2002 Community Capacity

Building Grant application for Hi-Crest Neighborhood Improvement Association,  
and authorize the Metropolitan Planning Department to apply for said grant from  
the Kansas Department of Commerce & Housing on September 27, 2002.
