RESOLUTION NO. 773

A RESOLUTION introduced by Mayor Harry Felker setting the public hearing for Lateral Sanitary Sewer Improvement Project No. 40644, Phase 3.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Topeka, Kansas, that a public hearing shall be held by the Governing Body of the City of Topeka, Kansas, on the advisability of the following: Lateral Sanitary Sewer Improvement Project No. 40644, Phase 3; said hearing to be held on November 5, 2002, in the City Council Chambers of City Hall, 214 East 8th Street, at 7:00 p.m., as provided by K.S.A. 12-6a04.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk shall publish the following notice of such public hearing in the official city newspaper in the manner provided by K.S.A. 12-6a04.

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City of Topeka, Kansas, will meet for the purpose of holding a public hearing as provided by K.S.A. 12-6a01 *et seq.*, in the City Council Chambers of City Hall, 214 East 8th Street, at 7:00 p.m. on November 5, 2002, to consider the advisability of the following:

A. GENERAL NATURE OF IMPROVEMENT:

To provide sanitary sewer service to the following described area with piping, manholes, engineering and all other contingencies required for a complete project.

B. PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT:

Lots 3 through 9, Block "E," Southboro Subdivision No. 2; and

Lots 2 through 9, Block "H," Southboro Subdivision No. 2; and  
Lots 20 through 23, Block "J," Southboro Subdivision No. 2.

C. ESTIMATED OR PROBABLE COST:

\$107,541.67

D. PROPOSED METHOD OF ASSESSMENT:

On a unit basis for all lots or individual dwelling sites which are included in the improvement district.

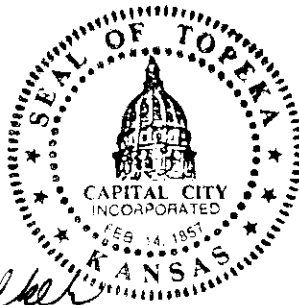
E. APPORTIONMENT OF COSTS:

100% to Improvement District as defined above.

The hearing may be adjourned from time to time and until the City Council shall have made findings by resolution as to the advisability of the improvement, the nature of the improvement, the estimated cost, the boundaries of the improvement district, the method of assessment and the apportionment of costs between the improvement district and the City at Large, all as finally determined by the City Council.

All persons desiring to be heard with reference to the proposed improvement shall be heard at this hearing.
