

1 RESOLUTION NO. 7355

3 A RESOLUTION introduced by Councilmember Clark Duffy granting university
4 United Methodist Church an exception to the provisions of City
5 of Topeka Code Section 54-148 concerning noise prohibitions.

7 WHEREAS, City of Topeka Code Section 54-148 makes it unlawful for
8 any person to make, continue or cause to made or continued any loud,
9 unnecessary or unusual noise or any noise which either annoys, disturbs, injures
10 or endangers the comfort, repose, health or safety or others within the limits of
11 the city; and

12 WHEREAS, City of Topeka Code Section 54-148 authorizes the City
13 Council to grant exceptions to the prohibitions of this code section upon request
14 and a showing that the proposed activity does not offend the spirit of the findings
15 of City of Topeka Code Section 54-146, and

16 WHEREAS, University United Methodist Church has requested that it be
17 granted an exception to the provisions of City of Topeka Code Section 54-148 for
18 the purposes, dates and times described herein, and


19 WHEREAS, upon review of the application of University United Methodist
20 Church the Council of the City of Topeka does hereby find that the requested
21 activity does not offend the spirit of the findings of City of Topeka Code Section
22 54-146.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of
24 Topeka that University United Methodist Church is hereby granted an exception
25 from the provisions of City of Topeka Code Section 54-148 while providing music

26 at its outdoor church picnic and ice cream social to be held at 1621 SW College
27 Avenue during the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. on June 21, 2003.
