4 RESOLUTION OF ADVISABILITY AND AUTHORIZATION NO. 7380

7 A RESOLUTION introduced by Mayor Harry Felker authorizing Street
8 Improvement Project No. 60593-01 as more specifically
9 described herein.
10

11 WHEREAS, the City Council has received a petition, pursuant to K.S.A. 12-6a04,
12 containing the signatures of the owners of 100% of the area in the improvement district
13 hereinafter described; and

14 WHEREAS, seven (7) days have elapsed since the filing of said petition.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Topeka,
16 Kansas, that it finds Street Improvement Project No. 60593-01, hereinafter described, to be
17 advisable and does hereby authorize and order said improvement to be made in
18 accordance with its findings as follows:

20 A. GENERAL NATURE OF IMPROVEMENT:
21

22 To pave NW Vail Court from the east edge of existing NW Vail Avenue to the
23 platted cul-de-sac of Meier's Place Subdivision; NW Greenwood Court from
24 the east edge of existing NW Vail Avenue to the platted cul-de-sac of Meier's
25 Place Subdivision; and NW 8th Street from the east edge of existing NW Vail
26 Avenue easterly to the east lines of Lot 9, Block "A" and Lot 3, Block "B,"
27 Meier's Place Subdivision with 29 foot wide concrete pavement including
28 concrete curb and gutter, sidewalk ramps, storm drainage facilities,
29 engineering, and all other contingencies needed to complete the project.

31 B. PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT:

33 Lots 1 through 9, Block "A;" Lots 1 through 3 and 9 through 14, Block "E;"
34 Meier's Place Subdivision, Topeka, Kansas.

43 improvement district.

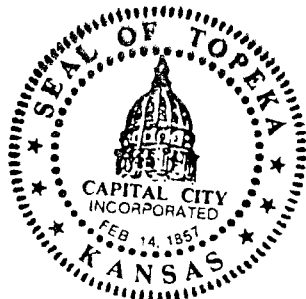
