18 NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

19 Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City of Topeka, Kansas, will meet for  
20 the purpose of holding a public hearing as provided by K.S.A. 12-6a01 et seq., in the City  
21 Council Chambers of City Hall, 214 E 8th Street, at 7:00 p.m. on March 23, 2004, to  
22 consider the advisability of the following:

23 A. GENERAL NATURE OF IMPROVEMENT:

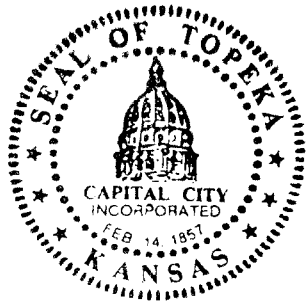
24 To provide sanitary sewer service to the following described area with piping,  
25 manholes, engineering and all other contingencies required for a complete  
26 project.

- 27 B. PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT:

 29 Lots 2, 3, and 4, Block "A," Crest Subdivision, Lot 1, Fix First Addition, less  
 30 the east 515 feet of said Lot 1  
 31  
 32 C. ESTIMATED OR PROBABLE COST:

 34 \$47,350.16  
 35  
 36 D. PROPOSED METHOD OF ASSESSMENT:  
 37  
 38 On a unit basis for all lots, or individual business sites which are included in  
 39 the improvement district.

 41 E. APPORTIONMENT OF COSTS:  
 42  
 43 100% Improvement District

44 The hearing may be adjourned from time to time and until the City Council shall  
 45 have made findings by resolution as to the advisability of the improvement, the nature of  
 46 the improvement, the estimated cost, the boundaries of the improvement district, the  
 47 method of assessment and the apportionment of costs between the improvement district  
 48 and the City at Large, all as finally determined by the City Council.

49 All persons desiring to be heard with reference to the proposed improvement shall  
 50 be heard at this hearing.
