

RESOLUTION NO. 7476

A RESOLUTION introduced by Mayor James A. McClinton, authorizing Improvement Project No. 29058-04 which provides for the replacement of the existing South Kansas Interceptor as more specifically described herein, and authorizing the same.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Topeka that it finds the following described public improvement to be necessary and in the public interest and does hereby authorize Improvement Project No. 29058-04 as hereinafter described:

A. GENERAL NATURE OF IMPROVEMENT:

This project consists of the replacement of the existing South Kansas Interceptor Sewer built in the late 1950's. The existing pipe in a 36-inch smooth flow corrugated steel pipe that has deteriorated beyond repair and lacks the capacity to handle new growth. The pipeline will consist of 7,700 linear feet of 42-inch sewer pipe, 20 lined concrete manholes, and other appurtenances for a complete project.

B. ESTIMATED OR PROBABLE COST:

\$4,428,000.00

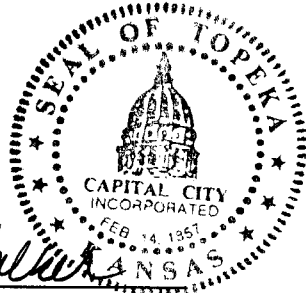
C. APPORTIONMENT OF COSTS:
