3 A RESOLUTION introduced by Councilmember John Alcala granting Fiesta
4 Mexicana an exception to the provisions of City of Topeka
5 Code Section 54-148 concerning noise prohibitions.

7 WHEREAS, City of Topeka Code Section 54-148 makes it unlawful for
8 any person to make, continue or cause to made or continued any loud,
9 unnecessary or unusual noise or any noise which either annoys, disturbs, injures
10 or endangers the comfort, repose, health or safety or others within the limits of
11 the city; and

12 WHEREAS, City of Topeka Code Section 54-148 authorizes the City
13 Council to grant exceptions to the prohibitions of this code section upon request
14 and a showing that the proposed activity does not offend the spirit of the findings
15 of City of Topeka Code Section 54-146, and

16 WHEREAS, Fiesta Mexicana has requested that it be granted an
17 exception to the provisions of City of Topeka Code Section 54-148 for the
18 purposes, dates and times described herein, and


19 WHEREAS, upon review of the application of Fiesta Mexicana, the
20 Council of the City of Topeka does hereby find that the requested activity does
21 not offend the spirit of the findings of City of Topeka Code Section 54-146.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of
23 Topeka that the City of Topeka that Fiesta Mexicana is hereby granted an
24 exception from the provisions of City of Topeka Code Section 54-148 while
25 celebrating and sharing Mexican culture with authentic Mexican food, Grammy

26 award-winning Latino entertainment, traditional dance, carnival rides, and crafts
27 at Our Lady of Guadalupe School, 210 NE Branner during the hours of 2:00 p.m.
28 and 12:00 a.m. from July 13, 2004 to July 18, 2004.
