4 A RESOLUTION introduced by Councilmember Clark Duffy relating to implementation
5 of the Topeka/Shawnee County Comprehensive Metropolitan Plan
6 2025 and the designation of jobs of high demand for the Advantage
7 Topeka Program.

9 WHEREAS, the Advantage Topeka Program forgives student loans for Topeka
10 graduates of the University of Kansas who stay in Topeka and become employed with
11 an industry of high demand; and

12 WHEREAS, the Advantage Topeka Program implements specific goals of the
13 Economic Development Element of the Topeka-Shawnee Comprehensive Metropolitan
14 Plan 2025; and

15 WHEREAS, City Section 4 of City of Topeka Ordinance No. 18132 requires the
16 Chief Administrative Officer to designate occupational areas of high demand before
17 June 2003 and as of this date, the Chief Administrative Officer has not yet made those
18 designations; and

19 WHEREAS, the Kansas Department of Human Resources has completed a
20 survey of jobs of high demand in Shawnee County.

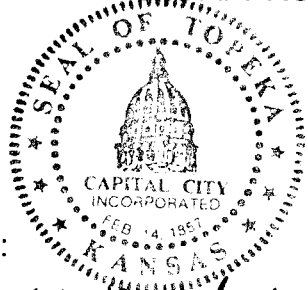
21 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the City Council directs the Chief
22 Administrative Officer to designate the following jobs identified by the Kansas
23 Department of Human Resources as jobs of high demand for purposes of complying
24 with Section 4 of City of Topeka Ordinance No. 18132 of the Advantage Topeka

25 Program: construction, transportation, installation, maintenance, repair, computers,
26 engineering, architecture and health care.

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon adoption and approval, a copy of this
28 Resolution shall be provided to the Chief Administrative Officer and the University of
29 Kansas.
