4 RESOLUTION OF ADVISABILITY AND AUTHORIZATION NO. 7522

7 A RESOLUTION introduced by Mayor James A. McClinton authorizing Street  
8 Improvement Project No. 60572, Phase 2 as more specifically  
9 described herein.  
10

11 WHEREAS, the City Council has received a petition, pursuant to K.S.A. 12-6a04,  
12 containing the signatures of the owners of 100% of the area in the improvement district  
13 hereinafter described; and

14 WHEREAS, seven (7) days have elapsed since the filing of said petition.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Topeka,  
16 Kansas, that it finds Street Improvement Project No.60572, Phase 2, hereinafter described,  
17 to be advisable and does hereby authorize and order said improvement to be made in  
18 accordance with its findings as follows:

20 A. GENERAL NATURE OF IMPROVEMENT:  
21

22 To pave SW Cambridge Avenue from the north line of Lot 12, Block A,  
23 southerly to SW 45th Street. Proposed paving will be 39' wide back-to-back,  
24 as a collector standard. These improvements will include concrete curb and  
25 gutter, asphalt pavement, sidewalk ramps, drainage facilities, and all other  
26 contingencies required to complete the project.

31 Lots 1 - 12, block "B"

On a unit basis for all lots or individual dwelling sites that are a part of this improvement district.

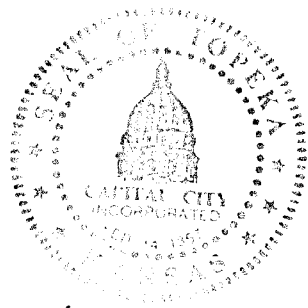
E. APPORTIONMENT OF COSTS:
