7 A RESOLUTION introduced by Mayor James A. McClinton authorizing Lateral
8 Sanitary Sewer District No. 40659-02 as more specifically

11 WHEREAS, the City Council has received a petition, pursuant to K.S.A. 12-6a04,
12 containing the signatures of the owners of 100% of the area in the improvement district
13 hereinafter described; and

14 WHEREAS, seven (7) days have elapsed since the filing of said petition.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Topeka,
16 Kansas, that it finds Lateral Sanitary Sewer District No. 40659-02, hereinafter described, to
17 be advisable and does hereby authorize and order said improvement to be made in
18 accordance with its findings as follows:

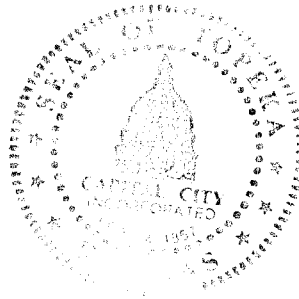
