22 construction, reconstruction, or repair of the sidewalk shall be levied against the owner's
23 land.

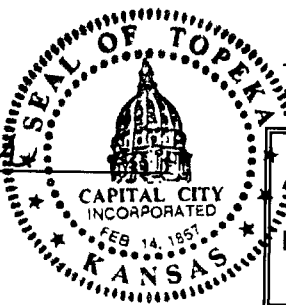
24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk shall publish the Resolution in the
