

RESOLUTION NO. 7571

A RESOLUTION introduced by Mayor James A. McClinton describing and authorizing Improvement Project No. 29095 which provides for the correction of inflow and infiltration into the City sanitary collection system as more specifically described herein.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Topeka, Kansas, that it finds the following described project to be necessary and in the public interest and does hereby authorize Improvement Project No. 29095 with a project budget as hereinafter described:

A. GENERAL NATURE OF PROJECT:

This project provides for the correction of inflow and infiltration into the City's sanitary collection system. Currently, combined dry weather flow at the North Topeka Waste Water Treatment Plant and the Oakland Waste Water Treatment Plant is eighteen million gallons per day. Wet weather flow, depending on the magnitude of the storm event, can approach ninety million gallons per day. The increase in flow during wet weather is caused by inflow and infiltration of storm water into the sanitary sewer system.

B. ESTIMATED OR PROBABLE COST:

\$1,400,000.00

C. APPORTIONMENT OF COSTS:

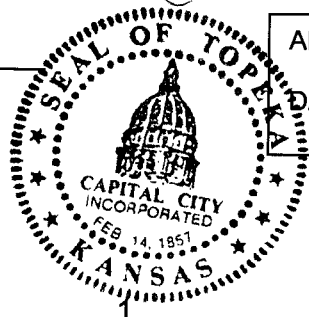
