3 RESOLUTION OF ADVISABILITY AND AUTHORIZATION NO. 7593

5 A RESOLUTION introduced by Mayor James A. McClinton authorizing Street
6 Improvement Project No. 60598-02 as more specifically
7 described herein.

9 WHEREAS, the City Council has received a petition, pursuant to K.S.A. 12-6a04,
10 containing the signatures of the owners of 100% of the area in the improvement district
11 hereinafter described; and

12 WHEREAS, seven (7) days have elapsed since the filing of said petition.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Topeka,
14 Kansas, that it finds Street Improvement Project No. 60598-02, hereinafter described, to be
15 advisable and does hereby authorize and order said improvement to be made in
16 accordance with its findings as follows:

17 A. GENERAL NATURE OF IMPROVEMENT:

19 To pave:

21 SE 22nd Terrace from west line of Lot 5, Block "B," Woodglen Subdivision to
22 the east line of said subdivision and Glenwood Court, Spruce Court, and
23 Baldwin Court from SE 22nd Terrace north to north end of each of the cul-de-
24 sacs, and SE Baldwin Road from SE 22nd Terrace to S.L. of said subdivision
25 with 29 foot wide pavement including concrete curb and gutter, sidewalk
26 ramps, storm drainage facilities, engineering, and all other contingencies
27 needed to complete the project.

29 B. PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT:

31 Lots 9 through 32, Block A and
32 Lots 5 thorough 13, Block B, all in Woodglen Subdivision, in the City of
33 Topeka, Kansas.
