8 A RESOLUTION introduced by City Manager Neil Dobler, setting forth the City of
9 Topeka's intention to acquire one (1) pumper fire truck, pursuant to
10 K.S.A. 12-110c.

12 BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Topeka, Kansas, that it hereby
13 declares its intention to issue general obligation bonds of the City of Topeka in the
14 amount of two hundred eighty-nine thousand nine hundred sixty-three dollars
15 (\$289,963.00) for the purpose of acquiring one (1) pumper fire truck.

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is hereby directed to make
17 every effort to utilize other lawfully available funds in lieu of issuing general obligation
18 bonds.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Council of City of Topeka, Kansas, that the
20 City Clerk shall cause this Resolution to be published once a week for two consecutive
21 weeks in the official City newspaper, all pursuant to K.S.A. 12-110c.
