6 A RESOLUTION introduced by Councilmember Lover Chancler relating to the  
7 installation of a traffic signal at the intersection of SE 6<sup>th</sup> Street and  
8 SE Deer Creek Trafficway.

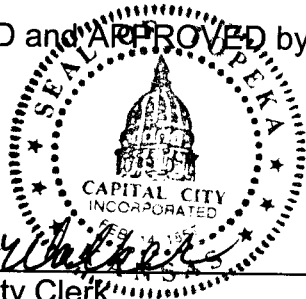

10 WHEREAS, presently the intersection of SE 6<sup>th</sup> Street and SE Deer Creek  
11 Trafficway experiences a high level of traffic; and

12 WHEREAS, due to the expansion of established businesses, economic  
13 development growth is currently occurring in the vicinity of this intersection. Further,  
14 economic development growth through the establishment of new businesses has been  
15 proposed and is expected to occur in the near future at this location; and

16 WHEREAS, due to the current heavy traffic flow and the likelihood of increased  
17 traffic that this economic development growth will bring to this intersection, the  
18 installation of a traffic signal is essential.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Topeka,  
20 Kansas, that the City Council requests Administration to instruct staff to ~~install~~ prepare a  
21 project budget to be funded in part by a limited benefit district for the installation of a  
22 traffic signal at the intersection of SE 6<sup>th</sup> Street and SE Deer Creek Trafficway that will  
23 accommodate current and future economic development growth at this location.
