3 RESOLUTION OF ADVISABILITY AND AUTHORIZATION NO. 7661

5 A RESOLUTION introduced by City Manager Neil Dobler authorizing Street
6 Improvement Project No. 60599-02 as more specifically
7 described herein.

9 WHEREAS, the City Council has received a petition, pursuant to K.S.A. 12-6a04,
10 containing the signatures of the owners of 100% of the area in the improvement district
11 hereinafter described; and

12 WHEREAS, seven (7) days have elapsed since the filing of said petition.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Topeka,
14 Kansas, that it finds Street Improvement Project No. 60599-02, hereinafter described, to be
15 advisable and does hereby authorize and order said improvement to be made in
16 accordance with its findings as follows:

17 A. GENERAL NATURE OF IMPROVEMENT:

19 To pave SE Scorpio Avenue, SE Taurus Avenue, SE Virgo Avenue, and SE
20 Aries Avenue with 29 foot wide pavement, including concrete curb and
21 gutter, sidewalk ramps, storm drainage facilities, and all other contingencies
22 needed to complete the project.

24 B. PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT:

26 Lot 1, Block A
27 Lots 1 through 5, Block B
28 Lots 6 through 14, Block F
29 Lots 1 through 15, Block G
30 Lots 1 through 13, Block H
31 Lots 1, and 32 through 35, Block I
32 all in the Aquarian Acres Subdivision No. 9, Topeka, Kansas
