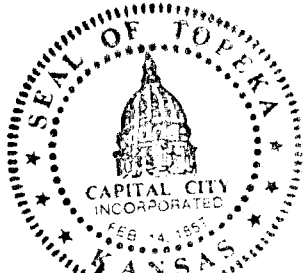
5 A RESOLUTION introduced by City Manager Neil Dobler authorizing initiation of
6 condemnation proceedings to acquire property for Improvement Project
7 No. 606130, for the second phase of the Washburn-Lane Parkway
8 project.

10 BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Topeka, Kansas, pursuant to
11 K.S.A. 26-201 that it is necessary and advisable in the public interest to condemn certain
12 private property in the City for Improvement Project No. 606130, for public park purpose
13 and such other public purposes as are authorized by law.

14 Pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 26-201, the Engineering Division is hereby
15 authorized and directed to cause a survey to be made by some competent engineer of
16 those private lands which are necessary to be appropriated for the improvement, and such
17 other public purposes as are authorized by law, and the City Engineer, or his designee, is
18 authorized and directed to file the report of the survey, including a description of those
19 private lands and interests to be acquired by condemnation, in the office of the City Clerk.

20 THIS RESOLUTION shall become effective upon one publication in the official city
21 newspaper.
