4 RESOLUTION OF ADVISABILITY AND AUTHORIZATION NO. 7779

7 A RESOLUTION introduced by City Manager Norton N. Bonaparte, Jr.,  
8 authorizing Improvement Project No. 40942 located in Stone  
9 Crest Subdivision as more specifically described herein.  
10

11 WHEREAS, the City Clerk has received a petition, pursuant to K.S.A. 12-6a04,  
12 containing the signatures of the owners of 100% of the area in the improvement district  
13 hereinafter described; and

14 WHEREAS, seven (7) days have elapsed since the filing of said petition.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Topeka,  
16 Kansas, that it finds Improvement Project No. 40942, hereinafter described, to be  
17 advisable and does hereby authorize and order said improvement to be made in  
18 accordance with its findings as follows:

20 A. GENERAL NATURE OF IMPROVEMENT:

22 To provide sanitary sewer service to the following described area with piping,  
23 force main, pump station, manholes, engineering and all other contingencies  
24 required for a complete project.

26 B. PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT:

28 Lots 1 through 31, Block 'A'; Lots 1 through 22, Block 'B'; Lots 1  
29 through 8, Block 'C'; Lots 1 through 9, Block 'D'; Lots 1 through 21,  
30 Block 'E'; Lots 1 through 31, Block 'F'; Lots 1 through 14, Block 'G';  
31 Lots 1 through 13, Block 'H'; and Lots 1 through 10, Block 'I', Stone  
32 Crest Subdivision, Topeka, Kansas.

D. METHOD OF ASSESSMENT:

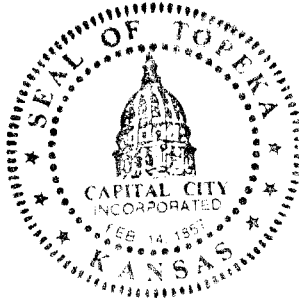
On a unit basis for all parcels which are included in the described improvement district.
