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4 RESOLUTION OF ADVISABILITY AND AUTHORIZATION NO. 7788
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7 A RESOLUTION introduced by City Manager Norton N. Bonaparte, Jr.,
8 authorizing Improvement Project No. 60624-01 located in the
9 Woodland Trail Subdivision as more specifically described
10 herein.
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12 WHEREAS, the City Clerk has received a petition, pursuant to K.S.A. 12-6a04,
13 containing the signatures of the owners of 100% of the area in the improvement district
14 hereinafter described; and

15 WHEREAS, seven (7) days have elapsed since the filing of said petition.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Topeka,
17 Kansas, that it finds Improvement Project No. 60624-01, hereinafter described, to be
18 advisable and does hereby authorize and order said improvement to be made in
19 accordance with its findings as follows:

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21 A. GENERAL NATURE OF IMPROVEMENT:
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23 To pave SE Arrow Nock Lane/S.E. 30th Street from the southerly line of Lot
24 6, Block B, Woodland Trail Subdivision, to the east line of Lot 1, Block B,
25 Woodland Trail Subdivision, and SE Melann Court from its intersection with
26 S.E. Arrow Nock Lane to the south line of Lot 16, Block A, Woodland Trail
27 Subdivision, and S.E. Tamboti Court, from its intersection with S.E. Arrow
28 Nock Lane to the south line of Lot 5, Block A, Woodland Trail Subdivision
29 with 29 foot wide pavement, including concrete curb and gutter, sidewalk
30 ramps, storm drainage facilities, engineering, and all other contingencies
31 needed to complete the project.
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33 B. PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT:
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35 Lots 1 through 23, Block 'A', and Lots 1 through 6, Block 'B', all in the
36 Woodland Trail Subdivision, Shawnee County Kansas, as recorded at
37 the office of the County Register of Deeds, Book 42, pages 17-20.

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C. ESTIMATED OR PROBABLE COST:

\$421,150.00

This cost estimate has been prepared using the best information available, without benefit of a detailed engineering design. Variances may occur as the design details are developed. These costs should not be considered final.

D. METHOD OF ASSESSMENT:

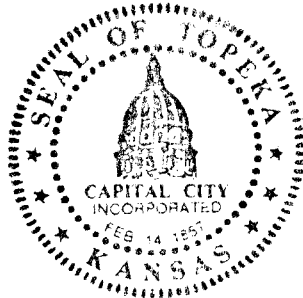
On a unit basis for all lots or individual dwelling sites which are included in the described improvement district.
