

1 RESOLUTION NO. 7819

3 A RESOLUTION introduced by Councilmember John Alcalá granting Fiesta  
4 Mexicana an exception to the provisions of City of Topeka  
5 Code Section 54-148 concerning noise prohibitions during its  
6 parade and street dance scheduled for July 7, 2006.  
7

8 WHEREAS, City of Topeka Code Section 54-148 makes it unlawful for  
9 any person to make, continue or cause to made or continued any loud,  
10 unnecessary or unusual noise or any noise which either annoys, disturbs, injures  
11 or endangers the comfort, repose, health or safety or others within the limits of  
12 the city; and

13 WHEREAS, City of Topeka Code Section 54-148 authorizes the City  
14 Council to grant exceptions to the prohibitions of this code section upon request  
15 and a showing that the proposed activity does not offend the spirit of the findings  
16 of City of Topeka Code Section 54-146, and

17 WHEREAS, Fiesta Mexicana has requested that it be granted an  
18 exception to the provisions of City of Topeka Code Section 54-148 for the  
19 purposes, dates and times described herein, and

20 WHEREAS, upon review of the application of Fiesta Mexicana, the  
21 Council of the City of Topeka does hereby find that the requested activity does  
22 not offend the spirit of the findings of City of Topeka Code Section 54-146.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of  
24 Topeka that the City of Topeka that Fiesta Mexicana is hereby granted an  
25 exception from the provisions of City of Topeka Code Section 54-148 while

26 celebrating and sharing Mexican culture with a parade and street dance on  
27 Quincy Street between 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Streets during the hours of 6:00 p.m. and  
28 12:00 midnight on July 7, 2006.
