

1 RESOLUTION NO. 7834

3 A RESOLUTION introduced by Deputy Mayor Jeff Preisner, granting Prairie  
4 Road Neighborhood Watch an exception to the provisions of  
5 City of Topeka Code Section 54-148 concerning noise  
6 prohibitions.

8 WHEREAS, City of Topeka Code Section 54-148 makes it unlawful for  
9 any person to make, continue or cause to made or continued any loud,  
10 unnecessary or unusual noise or any noise which either annoys, disturbs, injures  
11 or endangers the comfort, repose, health or safety or others within the limits of  
12 the city; and

13 WHEREAS, City of Topeka Code Section 54-148 authorizes the City  
14 Council to grant exceptions to the prohibitions of this code section upon request  
15 and a showing that the proposed activity does not offend the spirit of the findings  
16 of City of Topeka Code Section 54-146; and

17 WHEREAS, Prairie Road Neighborhood Watch has requested that it be  
18 granted an exception to the provisions of City of Topeka Code Section 54-148 for  
19 the purposes, dates and times described herein, and

20 WHEREAS, upon review of the application of Prairie Road Neighborhood  
21 Watch, the Council of the City of Topeka does hereby find that the requested  
22 activity does not offend the spirit of the findings of City of Topeka Code Section  
23 54-146.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of  
25 Topeka that Prairie Road Neighborhood Watch is hereby granted an exception

26 from the provisions of City of Topeka Code Section 54-148 for amplified outdoor  
27 music at the National Night Out Against Crime event located at Fairlawn Plaza  
28 Mall, 2114 SW Chelsea Drive, during the hours of 6:30 p.m. and 9:30 p.m. on  
29 August 5, 2006. The event will be held in the parking area behind Bank of  
30 America.
