

1 RESOLUTION NO. 7836

3 A RESOLUTION introduced by City Manager Norton N. Bonaparte, Jr., granting
4 exceptions to the provisions of City of Topeka Code Section
5 54-148 concerning noise prohibitions.

7 WHEREAS, City of Topeka Code Section 54-148 makes it unlawful for
8 any person to make, continue or cause to made or continued any loud,
9 unnecessary or unusual noise or any noise which either annoys, disturbs, injures
10 or endangers the comfort, repose, health or safety or others within the limits of
11 the city; and

12 WHEREAS, City of Topeka Code Section 54-148 authorizes the City
13 Council to grant exceptions to the prohibitions of this code section upon request
14 and a showing that the proposed activity does not offend the spirit of the findings
15 of City of Topeka Code Section 54-146; and

16 WHEREAS, neighborhood organizations listed below have requested that
17 they be granted an exception to the provisions of City of Topeka Code Section
18 54-148 for the purposes, dates and times described herein, and

19 WHEREAS, upon review of the application of the neighborhood
20 organizations listed below, the Council of the City of Topeka does hereby find
21 that the requested activity does not offend the spirit of the findings of City of
22 Topeka Code Section 54-146.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of
24 Topeka that neighborhood organizations listed below are hereby granted an
25 exception from the provisions of City of Topeka Code Section 54-148 for

26 amplified outdoor music at the National Night Out Against Crime event on August
27 5, 2006, as specified below:
