

1 RESOLUTION NO. 7838

3 A RESOLUTION introduced by Councilmember Clark Duffy, granting the West of
4 Washburn Neighborhood Watch an exception to the provisions
5 of City of Topeka Code Section 54-148 concerning noise
6 prohibitions.

8 WHEREAS, City of Topeka Code Section 54-148 makes it unlawful for
9 any person to make, continue or cause to made or continued any loud,
10 unnecessary or unusual noise or any noise which either annoys, disturbs, injures
11 or endangers the comfort, repose, health or safety or others within the limits of
12 the city; and

13 WHEREAS, City of Topeka Code Section 54-148 authorizes the City
14 Council to grant exceptions to the prohibitions of this code section upon request
15 and a showing that the proposed activity does not offend the spirit of the findings
16 of City of Topeka Code Section 54-146; and

17 WHEREAS, the West of Washburn Neighborhood Watch has requested
18 that it be granted an exception to the provisions of City of Topeka Code Section
19 54-148 for the purposes, dates and times described herein, and

20 WHEREAS, upon review of the application of the West of Washburn
21 Neighborhood Watch, the Council of the City of Topeka does hereby find that the
22 requested activity does not offend the spirit of the findings of City of Topeka
23 Code Section 54-146.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of
25 Topeka that the West of Washburn Neighborhood Watch is hereby granted an

26 exception from the provisions of City of Topeka Code Section 54-148 for
27 amplified outdoor music at the National Night Out Against Crime Neighborhood
28 Carnival located at Washburn University, 1700 SW College Avenue, during the
29 hours of 6:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m. on August 5, 2006. The event will be held on
30 the southwest corner of the campus at 21st Street and MacVicar Avenue.
