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3 RESOLUTION OF ADVISABILITY AND AUTHORIZATION NO. 7873  
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5 A RESOLUTION introduced by City Manager Norton N. Bonaparte, Jr.,  
6 amending the project budget and adopting as amended  
7 Improvement Project No. 60364-02 which provides for a turn-a-  
8 round at the east end of Southwest Reeder Street in front of  
9 the Kuhn-Smith Subdivision, pursuant to K.S.A. 12-6a01, *et*  
10 *seq.*, as amended, and rescinding City of Topeka Resolution of  
11 Advisability and Authorization No. 7647.  
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13 WHEREAS, the City Council adopted and approved Resolution of Advisability and  
14 Authorization No. 7647 which authorized Street Improvement Project No. 60364-02 with an  
15 Estimated Probable Cost of Nineteen Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty-Six Dollars  
16 (\$19,956.00), effective June 29, 2005; and

17 WHEREAS, the Estimated Probable Cost of the project has increased to Twenty-  
18 Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$24,500.00); and

19 WHEREAS, the City Clerk has received a revised petition, pursuant to K.S.A. 12-  
20 6a01, *et seq.*, as amended, containing the signatures of the owners of 100% of the area in  
21 the improvement district hereinafter described, and which petition sets forth the increased  
22 Estimated Project Cost of Twenty-Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$24,500.00).

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Topeka,  
24 Kansas, that it finds the following described public improvement to be necessary and in the  
25 public interest and does hereby authorize, pursuant to K.S.A. 12-6a01, *et seq.*, as  
26 amended, Street Improvement Project No. 60364-02 with an amended project budget as  
27 hereinafter described:  
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A. GENERAL NATURE OF IMPROVEMENT:

To provide a turn-a-round at the east end of Southwest Reeder Street in front of the Kuhn-Smith Subdivision.

B. PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT:

Lot 6, Block "A", Kuhn-Smith Subdivision.

C. ESTIMATED OR PROBABLE COST:

\$24,500.00

D. METHOD OF ASSESSMENT:

On a unit basis for all lots or individual dwelling sites which are included in the described improvement district.

E. APPORTIONMENT OF COSTS:

100% by the Improvement District

Upon completion of the project described herein, the City Clerk is hereby directed to provide all publication and mailed notices in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 12-6a01, *et seq.*, as amended.

BE IT RESOLVED that City of Topeka Resolution No. 7647 is hereby rescinded.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED this Resolution shall become effective upon one publication in the official city newspaper.
