

- 26 • Oppose legislation that interferes, abrogates or otherwise preempts local control
27 over franchise agreements and fees for utilities, cable television,
28 telecommunications and other providers utilizing the public right-of-way.
- 29 • To the extent consistent with the goals of the City of Topeka, support the 2007
30 Legislative Priorities of the League of Kansas Municipalities.
- 31 • Institution of statewide building codes.
- 32 • Institution of statewide licensing for building trades (one license allows
33 tradesmen to work anywhere in the state).
- 34 • Support legislation that amends suspended driver's license statutes to allow for
35 more cost effective and reasonable enforcement of and penalties for violations.
