

1 **RESOLUTION NO. 7916**

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4 A RESOLUTION introduced by City Manager Norton N. Bonaparte, Jr., describing the  
5 areas to be considered priorities for 2007 Target Areas for federal  
6 and city funding as allocated within the 2007 City budget.  
7 Furthermore, a designation of the areas to be considered priorities for  
8 2007 Planning Target Areas for future federal and city funding as may  
9 be allocated within the 2008, 2009 City budgets.

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12 BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Topeka, Kansas, that it finds the  
13 following described new project areas as priorities for redevelopment areas, commonly  
14 known as Target Areas, for available 2007 allocated and identified funding sources to be  
15 determined within the City Consolidated Plan and approved by the U. S. Department of  
16 Housing & Urban Development and through the City budget process. The funds are to be  
17 utilized for neighborhood revitalization, infrastructure and affordable housing initiatives to  
18 support targeting efforts and housing programs implemented by the Department of Housing  
19 & Neighborhood Development and the City of Topeka.

20 These Target Areas are considered viable to neighborhood redevelopment and  
21 improvement of such areas to be in the public interest and the city council does hereby  
22 authorize and confirm the 2007 Target Area priorities. Such areas are described as  
23 follows:

- 24 2007 Target Areas  
25 Hi-Crest  
26 East Topeka North  
27 Chesney Park  
28 Old Town  
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30 Furthermore, that it finds the following described new project areas as priorities for  
31 Planning areas and potential future redevelopment areas, commonly known as Target

32 Areas, for available 2008/2009 allocated and identified funding sources to be determined  
33 within the City Consolidated Plan and City budget process. The 2007 year shall be utilized  
34 for the development of revised and new neighborhood plans and determination of needs for  
35 concentrated neighborhood revitalization, infrastructure and affordable housing initiatives to  
36 support targeting efforts and housing programs implemented by the Department of Housing  
37 & Neighborhood Development and the City of Topeka.

38 These Planning Target Areas are considered viable to neighborhood redevelopment  
39 and improvement of such areas to be in the public interest and the city council does hereby  
40 authorize and confirm the 2007 Planning Target Area priorities. Such areas are described  
41 as follows:

44 Historic Holliday Park
