5 A RESOLUTION introduced by City Manager Norton N. Bonaparte, Jr., authorizing
6 initiation of condemnation proceedings to acquire property interests for
7 Street Improvement Project No. 60619-00 which provides for paving
8 certain streets located in Horseshoe Bend Subdivision and Sewer
9 Improvement Project No. 40936-01 which provides for sanitary sewer
10 service to Horseshoe Bend Subdivision.

12 BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Topeka, Kansas, pursuant to
13 K.S.A. 26-201 that it is necessary and advisable in the public interest to condemn certain
14 private property in the City for the public purposes of Street Improvement Project No.
15 60619-00 which provides for paving certain streets located in Horseshoe Bend Subdivision
16 and Sewer Improvement Project No. 40936-01 which provides for sanitary sewer service to
17 Horseshoe Bend Subdivision and such other public purposes as are authorized by law.

18 Pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 26-201, the Engineering Division is hereby
19 authorized and directed to cause a survey to be made by some competent engineer of
20 those private lands which are necessary to be appropriated for the improvements, and such
21 other public purposes as are authorized by law, and the City Engineer, or her designee, is
22 authorized and directed to file the report of the survey, including a description of those
23 private lands and interests to be acquired by condemnation, in the office of the City Clerk.

24 THIS RESOLUTION shall become effective upon one publication in the official city
25 newspaper.
